Getting a girl below 18 years and a boy below 21 years married is a punishable offence. As per the Child Marriage Prevention Act 2006, any one pressurising a child to get married at an early age is liable for punishment.



Types of offences

- Encouraging or helping to get children married
- Not taking measures to stop a child marriage from taking place
- Participating in a child marriage

Who all are guilty

- Any person or organisation participating in child marriage
- Parents
- Guardians

Extent of Punishment

2 years imprisonment

Fine

Fine up to Rs 1 lakh
