Adopting a homeless or an orphaned child

Adopting a child is legally valid (Section 22, Juvenile Justice Act)



Child Welfare
Committee has
certified that one
is free to adopt any
child less than six
years of age.



A child can be legally adopted only through specialised adoption agencies duly approved and licensed by the state government.



Centralised Adoption Resource Authority (CARA) is the designated central agency by the Government of India and is responsible for issuing guidelines and rules related to the adoption of Indian children.
